Programme

You are invited to arrive at the Centre after 4pm on the Monday when you will be welcomed with afternoon tea.

For those staying in the Centre, a three course meal will be served each evening at 6pm and a buffet breakfast is offered each morning at 8.30am.

The Bible Week finishes after the morning meeting on Friday. The Walking Week finishes after lunch on the Friday.



Staying half-board in the Convention Centre:

Guests who prefer to make their own accommodation arrangements are welcome as 'day visitors' on the Bible Week only (11-15 Oct), but should plan to stay for the whole week rather than just attending for one or two days. Day visitors can also book evening meals.

All guests, including day visitors, need to complete a booking form and return it with a non-returnable deposit of £60 per person in order to reserve a place. The balance will then be due 4 weeks before you arrive (a reminder will be enclosed with your welcome letter).
