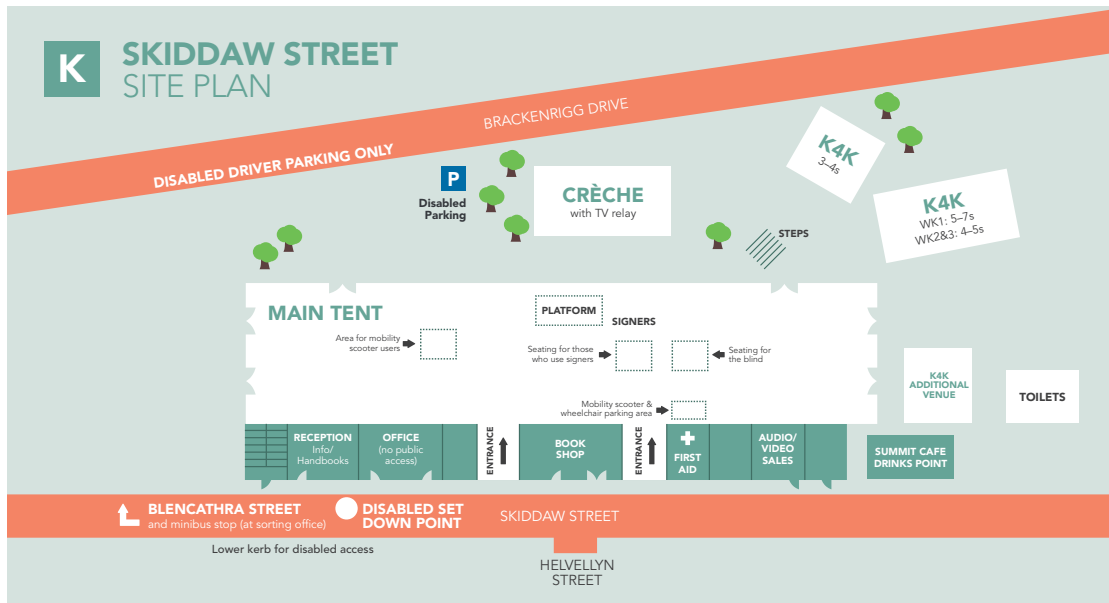


Site Plans

Please note these plans are purely diagrammatical and not to scale.



For visitors who use mobility scooters or wheelchairs, there are two options for seating in the Main Tent:

- If you (with a companion) wish to stay in your scooter or wheelchair for the duration of the meeting, please use the area to the left of the platform (as indicated on plan)
- If you wish to park your scooter or wheelchair, and walk to a seat of your choice, please use the designated parking area near to the First Aid Room (as indicated on plan)
