Some tactics from the father in Proverbs as he seeks to teach, guide and protect his son through the everyday battles of life (in no particular order...)

ONE | Don't just teach; persuade.

TWO | Don't be a practical atheist; begin with fearing God.

THREE | Don't merely aim at behavior; aim at the heart.

FOUR | Don't just say 'no'; tell a better story.

FIVE | Don't outsource spiritual education; educate your family.

SIX | Don't just focus on earthly consequences; teach eternity.

SEVEN | Don't be naïve; know your children's battles.

EIGHT | Don't just speak God's truth; uncover Satan's lies.

NINE | Don't always be black and white; but sometimes, be black and white.

TEN | Don't disguise the cost of folly; it might cost them everything.

ELEVEN | Don't disguise the cost of wisdom; it might cost them everything.

TWELVE | Don't just say it once; say it over, and over, and over again.

THIRTEEN | Don't expect perfection; model repentance.

FOURTEEN | Don't be wise in your own eyes; admit your folly.
