Covid Procedures for all Conventioners

Covid 19 is a serious and infectious disease – and it will still be prevalent during the Convention

We want everyone on the site to be as safe as possible

The Convention will be operated as a Covid Secure Site

Procedures

- If you have **symptoms of Covid 19** you should not come to the Convention site.
- Anyone displaying symptoms will be asked to leave the site
- If you feel ill or develop symptoms while on the site, you should leave the site immediately.
 - You should follow English government guidance.
 - You should not return to the site without first having had a negative PCR test result.

• Lateral Flow Tests

- \circ Lateral Flow tests are obligatory for all over the age of 11.
- Tests should be taken before you travel to the Convention and then Wednesday morning before coming on site, each week.
- \circ $\,$ You should not come to the site if you or a member of your family or bubble tests positive.
 - You should follow English government guidance.
 - You should not return to the site without first having had a negative PCR test result.
- \circ $\;$ Stewards and site security may ask for proof of a negative test.
- If Conventioners are unable to provide proof of a negative lateral flow test they will be asked to leave the site.
- Conventioners may meet in groups of six or two households inside venues or groups of thirty outside.
- Apart from the exception directly above, **Social Distancing** of one metre plus is required inside. "Plus" means wearing a mask in addition to 1m separation. If masks aren't worn a distance of 2m should be observed.
- **Masks** should be worn inside.
- Frequent hand washing should be observed.
- While current government guidelines prevail, there will be no congregational singing
- Conventioners are encouraged to use **NHS Track and Trace** each venue has a Track and Trace QR code. We will also have paper-based method in venues for those Conventioners without the Track and Trace App to provide details.

Youth Programme

- Young people on the Youth programme should observe all the above procedures
- **Masks** should be worn inside except when seated with your small group bubble
- Parents should inform the youth team if their child develops symptoms, and take them for a PCR test as soon as possible
- Parents should inform the youth team as soon as possible whether the test is positive or negative
- If a youth (or leader) tests positive, that young person and their particular small group bubble will have to leave the site and isolate
- Please note that your child may have to isolate because someone in their small group bubble tests positive.
