Our new series of The Keswick Convention podcast is out now! In this series James Cary and Rachel Redeemed chat to speakers at this



Dear friends,

In what has been another very challenging year, we are so thankful to the Lord for His continued faithfulness. Work on the refurbishment of the Pencil Factory is continuing apace, and we plan, God willing, to have the first and second floors refurbished and available for children's and youth work at this year's Convention. This phase of work involves the installation of lifts and stairs, new windows and rendering to the rear of the building, as well as putting in heating, lighting and ventilation.

To date, through the generosity of God's

people, we have received £6.8m of the £8.0m target that was set at the outset of the project, leaving a further £1.2m still to raise.

Your continued support is very much appreciated as we seek to bring the building element of the Derwent Project to completion, creating a facility which will be used for generations to come. At the heart of it will be a new home for the Convention, all on one site, but also a place where many more teaching and training activities can take place throughout the year, for the equipping and refreshing of God's people and to bring glory to his name.





