There have been many important milestones throughout the history of the Keswick Convention; but one of the most significant has happened in our time – the Derwent Project.

Ten years ago, the Lord gave the Trustees the vision for a larger, integrated site as a home for the Keswick Convention and for year-round ministry. Since then, we have seen God powerfully at work through the wonderful provision of the Pencil Factory.

We purchased this site in 2015, and over the last four years there has been huge progress in refurbishing what was once a derelict building into a space for inspiring local and global mission.

Our goal for this project was to raise £8 million to transform the Pencil Factory into a new home for the Keswick Convention and the expanding ministry. Thanks to the generosity of Keswick Ministries supporters, we're very close to achieving this goal.

Having raised over 90% of the target, we need £750,000 to complete the project by summer 2024.


Our Mission

For nearly 150 years, Keswick Ministries has united God's people and strengthened churches around the Word of God. The Convention has grown from a small gathering on the lawn at St John's Church, Keswick in 1875, to become a global movement for spiritual renewal and growth. We now welcome between 12,000 – 15,000 Christians from across the UK and beyond each year over 3 weeks in the summer.

By God's grace and for His glory, Keswick Convention has impacted Christians all over the world and seen Bible Conventions with the same ethos and passion spring up all over the UK, in other parts of Europe, and worldwide.

Our Goals

To secure the future of the threeweek summer Convention on an integrated site at the heart of the town of Keswick, giving Christians of all ages opportunities to worship, study God's Word and encourage each other during Keswick Convention and throughout the year.

To establish a new centre of operations for Keswick Ministries' team.

To expand the scope of Keswick Ministries by providing a conference facility for a range of activities at other times of the year, including training programmes and Bibleteaching events.

To make the conference facility available to churches in the UK and beyond – particularly serving Cumbria and the North (including Scotland) – as well as a facility for the local community.

The story so far

Thanks to God's guidance and provision through Keswick Ministries supporters, we have already made significant progress through the Derwent Project:

- In 2015, we purchased the Pencil Factory site.
- In 2019, we were granted planning permission for refurbishment of the site.
- We have made huge progress in refurbishing the Pencil Factory building, enabling increased use for ministry:
 - During Keswick Convention 2022, children's and youth groups – along with seminars, lectures and other programme activities – took place within the Pencil Factory.
 - Throughout the rest of the year, an even greater range of Bible teaching events is being hosted within the Pencil Factory welcoming an increased number of attendees.
 - Local community groups have also started using the space and there is increasing interest from other organisations looking for venue space in the heart of the Lake District.

Next steps

1. Convention

Formally, open the doors of the newly refurbished Pencil Factory at Keswick Convention 2023, celebrating the gift of this significant and flexible space, which will be completely accessible and will enhance ministry to all ages, especially children and youth.

2. Teaching & Training

Complete the venue facilities, including the kitchens and reception, so that the building is a flexible and high-quality venue for a greater range of Bible teaching events, welcoming larger numbers throughout the year.

3. Serving the church and local community

Complete the conference facilities, including practical amenities and aesthetics, so that the building is a welcoming, accessible, and high-quality venue fit for serving churches as well as the local community.

4. Support the Keswick Ministries team

Relocate the centre of operations for Keswick Ministries to the Pencil Factory site, supporting the expanding staff team and establishing a recognisable and welcoming face for those visiting the Pencil Factory. "One of the things that struck me about Keswick Convention was the extent to which it continues to be an event for everyone with a global mission emphasis and heart. Throughout the programme, this was a natural priority for all, not just a specialist stream for a few."

Opportunities to support

Audio Visual Equipment

Installing sound and tech equipment throughout the Pencil Factory, reducing hire costs for Convention and ministry events during the year, as well as serving church groups and offering greater flexibility for venue hire.

Venue Aesthetics


Investing in the feel and ambience to welcome new and returning visitors to the home of Keswick Ministries, sharing where the Convention has come from and pointing visitors towards the gospel.

Kitchen Facilities

Installing two purpose-built kitchens, expanding the range of events that can be hosted in the Pencil Factory year-round and serving Convention volunteers, church groups and local community events.

Staff Offices

Providing the expanding Keswick Ministries staff team with permanent offices on the Pencil Factory site.



Packing Hall Redevelopment

Creating a useable space for the Convention and for venue hire yearround in this unique building, allowing greater flexibility for hosting more activities throughout the year and increasing the return on investment when hiring the space out.

External Works

Ensuring that we are good neighbours by keeping a presentable site and caring for the building and green spaces as stewards of this gift from God.

Site Accessibility

Making the Pencil Factory accessible to all by completing lift installation, reception areas and exterior accessibility that will create a welcome and flexible space enabling everyone to enjoy worshiping together on one site.

Landscape Works

Enhancing and caring for the landscape surrounding the Pencil Factory, in recognition of God's wonderful creation surrounding the venue.


Recurring Gifts: Every gift makes a difference
