Keswick Ministries (KM) is seeking a committed evangelical Christian leader to be our new Ministry Director. Capitalising on our newly enlarged and refurbished site in Keswick, you will shape and oversee the design, delivery and development of all our work including the three-week summer Keswick Convention and our growing year-round Teaching and Training programme. You will work closely with the KM trustees to develop and implement strategy and will lead a committed team of staff and volunteers to ensure that the organisation reflects its evangelical position and distinctives at every point of ministry.

About Keswick Ministries

Keswick Ministries exists to inspire and equip Christians to love and live for Christ in His world. Our three priorities are to hear God's Word, to become like God's Son, and to serve God's mission in the world. At the centre of what we do is the Keswick Convention, begun in 1875, which attracts some 15,000 Christians from the UK and around the world to Keswick every summer. It provides Bible teaching for all ages, vibrant sung worship, a sense of unity across generations and denominations, and an inspirational call to serve Christ in the world.

We are at an exciting period in Keswick Ministries' history. We are nearing the completion of the Derwent Project, which involves the commissioning of the disused Pencil Factory site in Keswick. This brings all our activities together in one location, and it serves the wider vision, to deliver a year-round ministry with a range of inspiring, equipping, Bible-centred teaching and training that focuses on 'whole of life' discipleship. In addition, we produce resources, both printed and digital, that point to Christ and help with daily discipleship. We also are a catalyst for the Keswick Fellowship, a fellowship of Bible Conventions in the UK and around the world that originate or draw their inspiration from the Keswick Convention.
