As we come expectantly to hear God's Word through the Bible Readings, it is good to prepare our hearts. One way of doing this is to pray and read through the passage in advance of the Bible Reading. Below are two questions for each day, to help us prepare.

1 John - How we can be sure

MONDAY

Because Christ has come: 1 John 1:1-2:2

- How does John emphasise his connection to Jesus? Why is this significant? (1:1-4)
- How does John describe God? How does he show its significance for our discipleship (1:5-2:2)?

TUESDAY

Because we now walk in the light: 1 John 2:3-27

- How do we know if someone belongs to God? What does this look like in practice? (2:3-17)
- How do we know if someone has received God's anointing?
 What do anointed ones need to do now? (2:18-27)

WEDNESDAY

Because of how we love: 1 John 2:28-3:24

- What is our new status and how is it expressed? (3:1-18)
- What is God's command? Why should obeying it give us confidence? (3:19-24)

THURSDAY

Because we have the Spirit: 1 John 4:1-5:5

- How do we know we have received God's Spirit? What difference does his Spirit make in our daily lives? (4:1-6)
- What does John emphasise about God's love? What does this teach us about how we are to love? (4:7-5:5)

FRIDAY

Because of what we believe: 1 John 5:6-21

- What do the water and blood signify? How do they testify to the truth about Jesus? (5:6-12)
- Why was this letter written? In what ways has reading it helped you? (5:13-21)
