## Colossians - Made and re-made in Christ

#### MONDAY

Created - Colossians 1:15-20

- How does Paul describe Jesus' relationship to creation in verse 15? What is the significance of this title? (1:15-17).
- What did Jesus' death and resurrection accomplish for the cosmos and for believers? (1:18-20).

#### **TUESDAY**

Reconciled - Colossians 1:21-23

- What was our former relationship to God? How was this evident? (1:21)
- How has our status and God's view of us changed? How can we be sure? (1:22-23)

#### **WEDNESDAY**

Made alive - Colossians 2:6-15

- How should we live after we become Christians? How is this significant for evangelism and discipleship? (2:6-7)
- In what way are we united to Christ? What blessings do we receive as a result?

### **THURSDAY**

Raised - Colossians 3:1-11

- What should our focus be if we have been 'raised with Christ'? Why? (3:1-4)
- What does this new focus mean in terms of practical obedience? What must we stop/start doing? (3:5-11)

#### **FRIDAY**

Loved - Colossians 3:12-17

- How has God treated us? How should that shape our behaviour? (3:12-14)
- What traits should characterise the church? What is our ultimate goal? (3:15-17)
