Foundations for Life in Genesis 1-11

MONDAY

Our God and his world - Genesis 1:1-2:3

- What can we learn about God from 1:1-25? In what ways do these verses help you look at creation with fresh eyes?
- Why did God create humans? In what ways do we carry out God's purposes today? (1:26-31).

TUESDAY

Being human and responsible - Genesis 2:4-25

- What was the man allowed to do/not do in the Garden of Eden? What was the consequence of disobedience? (2:4-17).
- What was Adam's relationship with the woman like? What are the implications for marriage relationships today? (2:18-25).

WEDNESDAY

The voice, the choice and the noise of sin - Genesis 3:1-6:8

- Why did Eve disobey God? How do we use the same reasoning to justify our disobedience to God? (Genesis 3:1-7).
- Genesis 6:5 says, 'The Lord saw how great the wickedness of the human race had become on the earth, and that every inclination of the thoughts of the human heart was only evil all the time'. Trace Genesis 3:1-6:8 to find evidence of this spiralling evil but also look for signs of hope.

THURSDAY

Rescued for relationship - Genesis 6:9-9:17

- What made Noah stand-out in his generation? What lessons about discipleship can we learn from him? (6:9-7:5)
- What was the promise/covenant God made with Noah? What significance does it have for us today?

FRIDAY

Rediscovering purpose in a rebellious world - Genesis 9:18-11:26

- What was wrong with the plan to build a tower? In what ways are we repeating the same sins today? (11:1-9)
- Why does the Bible include the Table of Nations and Shem's family line? (10:1-32, 11:10-26). What encouragement and hope can we take from these lists?
