Praise

- Evangelicals account for more than 1% of French population for first time since Reformation
- 15 times more evangelicals in France today than in 1950
- A new evangelical church opens somewhere in France every 10 days
- Opportunities for witness around upcoming sporting events: Rugby World Cup (autumn 2023), Olympic Games (summer 2024)





France

Prayer

- Not enough pastors to lead these new believers & churches
- 1000 new pastors needed over next 10 years
- CNEF (National Council of French Evangelicals) goal of 1 church per 10,000 inhabitants (currently 1 per 25,000)
- Biggest Muslim-background population in western Europe (c. 5%)
- Abuse scandals associated with Church
- Social tensions (riots of June/July 2023)
