Thursday 2	Thanking God that IT can be used effectively for his purposes, pray for the opening of online Volunteer and Mission Exhibition applications this month. Pray that the website and IT systems are not overloaded; and that the process is efficient and easy to navigate.
Friday 3	Pray for the ongoing conflicts in the world today and specifically for those affected through the Russia/Ukraine & Israel/Gaza wars. Pray for cessation of hostilities, diplomatic resolutions, and safety for civilians caught in extremely challenging circumstances.
Saturday 4	Pray for St Johns Parish Church in Keswick and Vicar Rev'd Charles Hope & staff. Pray for their weekly services, and their preparations for Advent. Pray that God would bless this church with good attendance from the community, clear and effective gospel ministry, and encouragement for those that serve here.
Sunday 5	Reflect on 1 Chron 16:11 & 12 "Look to the Lord and his strength; seek his face always. Remember the wonders he has done, his miracles, and the judgments he pronounced."
Monday 6	Praise God for the provision of finances for Keswick Ministries in 2023 and pray that as the budgets are set for 2024, God will continue to be our rock and provide for the work of the ministry.
Tuesday 7	Pray for all the volunteers that are applying to serve at next year's Convention. Pray that their application process goes smoothly, and that God blesses their sacrifice of time and skills.
Wednesday 8	Pray for Keswick Ministries newsletters and social media campaigns promoting KM's online resources, serving opportunities, and verses of encouragement. Pray that many Christians are strengthened in their faith as they use and share these resources.
