Monday 1	Isaiah 60 "Arise, shine, for your light has come, and the glory of the Lord rises upon you. See, darkness covers the earth and thick darkness is over the peoples, but the Lord rises upon you and his glory appears over you. Nations will come to your light, and kings to the brightness of your dawn." Pray that many will encounter Jesus, the Light of the World, through all interactions with Keswick Ministries programs and events in 2024.
Tuesday 2	Remember the Keswick Ministries staff team this week as they come back to the office after the Christmas break. Pray that morning devotions would continue to be the highlight of their day, anticipated with joy as they reflect on God's word, provision and character together.
Wednesday 3	Pray for this month's Keswick event the Bible workshop: Isaiah and the Gospels. Matt Searles will be teaching, pray for his preparation, and for delegates attending, that both will deepen their understanding of Isaiah's vision and portrait of Jesus - 'our King in his beauty' Isaiah 33:17
Thursday 4	Thanking God for the many year-round volunteers that support the day to day working of Keswick Ministries, pray for good health and strength for those planning to attend next month's volunteer week.
Friday 5	Pray for the town of Keswick. Pray for Keswick Ministries' relationship with residents and businesses as they hire and use the Pencil Factory and Rawnsley Centre.
Saturday 6	Pray for Keswick Churches this weekend, for well attended services, clear gospel proclamation and faithfulness to God's word.
Sunday 7	Psalm 96:6-10 "Splendour and Majesty are before him; strength and glory are in his sanctuary. Ascribe to the Lord, all you families of nations, ascribe to the Lord glory and strength. Ascribe to the Lord the glory due his name; bring an offering and come into his courts. Worship the Lord in the splendour of his holiness; tremble before him, all the earth." As many churches mark Epiphany today, pray that the celebration of God manifesting himself and his Salvation in the person of Jesus would cause us to wonder and worship Him afresh.
Monday 8	Pray for next month's Pastor's Refreshment Conference. Pray that God would use this conference to build up and encourage those in full time Christian ministry. Pray for those leading this event, that God would give them wisdom and insight as they prepare to counsel and guide the delegates.
Tuesday 9	With gratitude for God's ongoing provision, pray that we can maintain timely payment records with local contractors and businesses and that God would bless our interactions with them.
Wednesday 10	Pray for Convention 2024 planning meetings. Pray that God is glorified in all aspects of the planning and that teams work together with respect, humility, and integrity.

Thursday 11	Pray today for Kids and Youth Team leaders. Pray that, even in January, God would stretch their time to allow them to begin preparing well for the summer teaching program. Pray for creativity and cultural relevance as they prepare. Pray that all leadership positions would be filled by the end of January.
Friday 12	Pray for the relationship between Keswick Ministries and local contractors, businesses, and accommodation providers. Pray that Keswick Ministries would be known for acting with integrity, honesty, and fairness in all things.
Saturday 13	Pray for Keswick Churches this weekend, for well attended services, clear gospel proclamation and faithfulness to God's word.
Sunday 14	Psalm 98 1-3 "Sing to the Lord a new song, for he has done marvellous things; his right hand and his holy arm have worked salvation for him. The Lord has made his salvation known and revealed his righteousness to the nations. He has remembered his love and his faithfulness to Israel; all the ends of the earth have seen the salvation of our God." Continue to pray for many who interact with Keswick Ministries resources and events to come into a living relationship with Jesus Christ.
Monday 15	Thanking God that IT can be used so effectively for His purposes, Pray God would bless those that provide IT support to the Keswick Ministries office staff.
