Saturday 1	Pray for the on-boarding and compliance for all Convention volunteers. Pray that on-line training is easy to access, DBS certificates are issued in a timely manner and that God is glorified throughout this process.
Sunday 2	Resurrection: Our theme for Convention 2024, Praise the Lord Jesus that he has gone before us in God's resurrection power, showing us the resurrection, we look forward to through Him.
Monday 3	Praise God for the next generation of Conventioneers - those that will attend the Kids and Youth (K & Y) programme this year. As K & Y registration opens today, please pray that parents can access it easily; there are minimal technical issues; and spaces available for all that hope to attend.
Tuesday 4	Praise God for the Keswick Ministry events held in May: successful Volunteer work week; Kids and Youth training day in Nottingham; Keswick Fellowship events in Maidstone, Llandudno and Ayrshire, and the Keswick Leadership Course. Pray for all those that attended will have been built up in their faith, equipped and encouraged in their areas of service, and a growing understanding of God's call on their lives.
Wednesday 5	Praying more specifically this month for Convention Week 2, pray that Hearing God's Word, Becoming like God's Son, and Serving God's Mission will permeate through all the events of this week.
Thursday 6	Continue to pray for the K & Y registration process this week and for the Keswick Ministries staff that are supporting families through the process. Pray that communication is easy and clear to follow, and that all who hope to attend will be able to get a place.
Friday 7	Pray for the Keswick Podcasts that are being prepared ahead of Convention 2024. Pray they will inspire engagement from younger generations of Conventioneers; be shared and used to start conversations about faith in Jesus Christ.
Saturday 8	Pray for "Fluid" the technical support at Convention. Praise God that technology, audio and video can serve God's purposes, allowing talks and seminars to reach a world-wide audience.
Sunday 9	1 Corinthians 2:9 & 10 "However, as it is written: "No eye has seen, no ear has heard, no mind has conceived what God has prepared for those who love him: - but God has revealed it to us by his Spirit." Praise God today for his grace and kindness to those that love him.
Monday 10	Pray for Keswick Fellowship event: Congleton Bible Week starting today, and for Martin Salter as he teaches from Galatians on the theme "Freed to Serve". Pray that those attending will catch a fresh glimpse of the freedom Christians have in the gospel and that this understanding will spur them on to new areas of service in the cause for Christ.

Sunday 16	1 Corinthians 15: 51-53 "Listen, I tell you a mystery: We will not all sleep, but we will all be changed, in a flash, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, the dead will be raised imperishable, and we will be changed. For the perishable must clothe itself with the imperishable, and the mortal with immortality."

Pray that as they continue to prepare the grounds, Pencil Factory and Packing Hall they would be kept safe, know joy and fellowship together and accomplish much in readiness for the final set-up in July.

Pray for attention to detail, unity as a team, and a sense of Serving God's mission as Convention draws nearer.
