Sunday 1	Isaiah 40:31 "But those who hope in the Lord will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary; they will walk and not be faint." Pray for our churches this weekend as many settle into a new term of faithfully preaching God's word.

Sunday 8	Romans 8:24-25 "For this hope we were saved. But hope that is seen is no hope at all. Who hopes for what they already have? But if we hope for what we do not yet have, we wait for it patiently."
Monday 9	Praise God for the many kids and youth that came to Convention this year. Pray for them as they start back in their schools, colleges and universities. Pray they have courage to stand for the Lord Jesus in an increasingly secular and challenging environment. Pray that their passion and joy would not be diminished, and they would grow in faith and commitment to Him.
