Hearing God's Word Becoming like God's Son Serving God's Mission

Wednesday 1	Isaiah 43:18-19 "Forget the former things; do not dwell on the past. See, I am doing a new thing! Now it springs up; do you not perceive it? I am making a way in the desert and stream in the wasteland."
Thursday 2	Pray that as we begin a new year, the ministry, our trustees and staff will be dependent on God, work with joy, in unity, to glorify him. Pray that morning devotions would continue to be the highlight of their day, as they reflect on God's word, provision and character together.
Friday 3	Praise and thank God with us at Keswick Ministries as we look forward to marking 150 years of the Keswick Convention in July. Pray that we will continue to hold fast to God's Word and faithfulness throughout this year and beyond. Pray that God would raise up more leaders to carry His mission forward.
Saturday 4	Pray for the Christian witness of the local Keswick churches. Pray that God would encourage them as they meet tomorrow around His word; pray that members would have full understanding of every good thing we have in Christ (Philemon 6) as they share the gospel in the town.
Sunday 5	Psalm 89: 1-4 "I will sing of the Lord's great love forever; with my mouth I will make your faithfulness known through all generations. I will declare that your love stands firm forever, that you established your faithfulness in heaven itself. You said, "I have made a covenant with my chosen one, I have sworn to David my servant, 'I will establish your line for ever and make your throne firm through all generations.'"

Saturday 11	Pray for all the local accommodation providers (hotels, self-catering agencies, youth hostels and campsites) that we use to house contributors and volunteers during Convention. Pray for good relationships and understanding of our values and mission; timely payments; and a favourable reputation within the tourism community here.
Sunday 12	Psalm 89: 5-8 "The heavens praise your wonders oh Lord, your faithfulness too, in the assembly of the holy ones. For whom in the skies above can compare with the Lord? Who is like the Lord among the heavenly beings? In the council of the holy ones God is greatly feared; he is more awesome than all who surround him. O Lord God almighty, who is like you? You are mighty, O Lord, and your faithfulness surrounds you."
Monday 13	Pray for Christian missionaries and organisations that work in areas of ongoing conflicts in the world today. Pray that God would give them stamina and resilience as they take a stand for the gospel, bringing comfort and compassion to those caught up in challenging circumstances.
Tuesday 14	Pray for next month's Pastoral Refreshment Conferences run by Keswick Ministries and Living Leadership. Pray for church leaders and their spouses as they come, to receive blessing and encouragement from the Lord and be refreshed in their ministries. Your arm is endued with power; your hand is strong, your right hand exalted."
