### Role Description | Keswick Convention 2026

The Campus Team are the first volunteers that Conventioners encounter as they step onto the site:

- Providing a warm welcome
- Guiding and directing visitors around campus safely
- Helping to keep the outdoor areas safe and clean

### Skills And Qualities Needed:

- Physically fit and able to be on feet for long periods
- Ability to carry or move heavy objects
- Follow direction and work as a team in a busy environment
- Have lots of energy, patience, a sense of humour and flexibility!
- Enjoy talking to people and assisting people with a variety of needs
- Good level of spoken English
- An appetite for fresh air is a must for this role!

### Schedule and Location:

- **Location:** Around campus site (outside)
- **Arrival:** Saturday 1pm
- **Departure:** The following Saturday morning
- **Hours:** Around 8 hours per day (split over shifts – some days may be slightly longer due to programme needs)

### Specific Tasks Include:

- Assisting with crowd control and safety on entrance and exit to the site
- Welcoming and guiding Conventioners around the site
- At peak times, managing road crossing, parking & positively directing people
- Clearing litter, emptying bins, cleaning spillages outside (bags & bins can be heavy)
- Helping to manage outdoor queues
- Moving large equipment i.e. gazebos/barriers
- Taking responsible action during emergency evacuations, directing people towards safe muster points

- Reporting bags left unattended
- Assisting with deliveries onto the campus
- Joining daily devotions and team briefings
- Supporting other teams as needs arise

## Further Information

- There are usually 3 daily shifts, 8-2pm, 2-5pm and 6-10.30pm
- You will usually work 2 out of the 3 shifts, with either the afternoon or evening off.
- Please note this role is based outside so make sure you have suitable clothing and footwear for Lake District weather!
