### Role Description | Keswick Convention 2026

The Kids and Youth ministry is a thriving and growing strand of the Convention. Our volunteers are essential to helping us serve these groups well, sharing the gospel in truth and love by:

- Assisting with teaching and leading small groups.
- Building relationships and caring for children and young people.
- Planning games, crafts, and activities.
- Helping to keep venues clean, tidy, and organised.

Our Kids and Youth ministry continues to grow, which is hugely exciting! It also brings the challenge of finding enough team members to ensure every child can attend.

Since most of our Kids' groups run only in the mornings, we've created a part-time Kids' and Youth role to open up opportunities for more volunteers.

Part-time Kids & Youth Volunteers serve in the mornings and then have the rest of the day free to relax, spend time with friends and family, and enjoy the evening programme at the Convention.

### Skills and Qualities Needed:

- Good communication skills to share the gospel in an appropriate way
- Be lively and enthusiastic!
- Love Jesus and a willingness to share this with children/young people
- Reliable and punctual
- Good at building new relationships
- Have recent experience of working with children/young people
- Have a good level of spoken English
- Be ready to support other teams when a need comes up

- Be willing to apply for an Enhanced Level DBS (not Scottish PVG) check through Keswick Ministries

- **Location:** The Pencil Factory (Kids), Packing Halls (Youth)

- **Arrival:** Saturday 1pm
- **Departure:** Following Friday after the morning session
- **Hours:** 9am-1.30pm plus prep time on Sunday afternoons

## Specific Tasks Include:

- Assist teaching children/young people the Bible – following the same passages as the adults
- Build relationships and caring for a small group of children/young people
- Get stuck into fun games, crafts and activities that support the Bible teaching
- Clean up the venues after each session – preparing them for the next session
- Be ready to support other teams as needs arise
- Assist with whatever is needed behind the scenes
