- Reliable and punctual
- Good at building new relationships
- Have recent experience of working with children/youth
- Have a good level of spoken English
- Be ready to support other teams when a need comes up

Additional Requirements:

- Attend the Kids and Youth training day on Saturday, 9th May 2026 10-4pm in Nottingham
- Be willing to apply for an Enhanced Level DBS (not Scottish PVG) check through Keswick Ministries
- Attend Sunday all age service at the convention

Schedule and Location:

- Location: Pencil Factory (Kids), Packing Halls (Youth)
- Arrival: Saturday 1pm
- **Departure**: The following Saturday morning
- Hours: Around 8 hours per day (split over shifts some days may be slightly longer due to programme needs)



Specific Tasks Include:

- Teach children/youth the Bible following the same passages as the adults
- Build relationships and caring for a small group of children/youth
- Get stuck into fun games, crafts and activities that support the Bible teaching
- Participate in team meetings, times of preparation, prayer and worship
- Clean up the venues after each session preparing them for the next session
- Be ready to support other teams as needs arise
- Assist with whatever is needed behind the scenes
- Preparing talks in timely manner before convention to allow leaders to check and give feedback

Further Information:

- You will be on duty each day during the week.
- We aim to give each volunteer a morning or evening off during the week.

Kids: Sunday night: 6:30pm - 9:30pm; Mon - Fri 9am - 1pm (approximate finish), 6:30pm - 9:30pm

Youth: Saturday night: 6:30pm - 10:30pm; Mon - Fri 9am - 1pm (approximate finish), 6:30pm - 10:30pm
