Date	Prayer
Sunday 1	1 Corinthians 15:1-2 "Now, brothers and sisters, I want to remind you of the gospel I preached to you, which you received and on which you have taken your stand. By this gospel you are saved, if you hold firmly to the word I preached to you. Otherwise, you have believed in vain."
Monday 2	Pray for our two annual Pastoral Refreshment Conferences which are running this week. These gatherings offer church leaders and their spouses time and space away from ministry to rest and be renewed. Pray that all who attend would be refreshed and encouraged.
Tuesday 3	Thank God for our partnership with Living Leadership who run the Pastoral Refreshment Conferences alongside Keswick Ministries. Pray for Living Leadership's director, Marcus Honeysett, as he speaks at both conferences on 'Streams in the Desert'.
Wednesday 4	Pray for our site team as they care for the buildings and venues God has entrusted to us, asking that their hard work would help create safe, warm, and welcoming spaces for all who gather there.
Thursday 5	Praise God for the work of Count Everyone In, inspiring and equipping God's church to be welcoming and accessible to all, especially to people with a learning disability. Pray for them as they prepare their programme for week 1 of the Convention.

Saturday 7	Praise God that our volunteer team is continuing to come together for the Convention. Pray for the teams which still have vacancies, that God would be calling the right people to those roles. Pray for wisdom for those processing volunteer applications and arranging logistics.
Sunday 8	Psalm 96:9-10 "Worship the Lord in the splendour of his holiness; tremble before him, all the earth. Say among the nations, 'The Lord reigns.' The world is firmly established, it cannot be moved; he will judge the peoples with equity."

Tuesday 10	As the programme for the 2026 Convention comes together, pray for all those preaching in the evening celebrations and leading seminar streams. Ask that God would speak to them as they prepare, and that their teaching would be rooted in truth, full of grace, and helpful.
Wednesday 11	Pray for the Keswick Ministries' staff team as they meet together this morning for a time of fellowship, prayer and encouragement. Pray that each member of the team would know the joy of the Lord as they serve him at work, in their churches and home lives.
Thursday 12	Pray for Keswick's business community. Ask God to support and bless those who run shops, cafés, and services, and that our presence in the town would be a source of goodwill and encouragement to them.
Friday 13	Pray for the monthly Keswick Fellowship event, Sleaford Bible Ministry , this evening where Matt Stone, minister of Stag Community Church Rotherham and Ardeen Road URC Doncaster, will be preaching. Pray that God would speak to all present, and for open hearts to receive his word.
Saturday 14	Pray for the planning and smooth running of The Keswick Weekend in April, a time of refreshment through God's Word and reflection on our unity in Christ Jesus. Pray that all who attend would be renewed and encouraged to live for Christ together.
Sunday 15	1 Timothy 2:1-4 "I urge, then, first of all, that petitions, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for all people—for kings and all those in authority, that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness. This is good, and pleases God our Saviour, who wants all people to be saved and to come to a knowledge of the truth."
Monday 16	Give thanks for the gift of worship and the chance to praise God together at Keswick Events. Pray for those leading us, that they would serve faithfully, helping everyone present to encounter God and respond in spirit and truth.
Tuesday 17	Pray for Keswick Ministries, that through all our activities and events we would help Christians deepen their faith, become more like Christ, and live out their calling in God's world.
Wednesday 18	Praise God for the free digital resources we have available for churches to use throughout the year. Pray that many church groups and individuals would use our talks, seminars and podcasts in conjunction with our study guides and devotionals to be built up and encouraged in their faith.
Thursday 19	Thank God for all the children and young people who attend the Convention every year. Pray for our Kids & Youth team as they prepare fun and engaging programmes for this year to help under-18s grow in their relationship with Jesus.
